Original engine configuration was with twin turbo's, later replaced with the more conventional naturally aspirated engine set up for increased reliability. The car comes with original bodywork in VDS livery and is well documented. In more recent years it has competed in CanAm races all over the US, Europe and South Africa and has been maintained to the highest standards. Comes with a letter by Trojan to certify that this is the best and most original M8F still in existence. Delivers 800 BHP and 702 NM torque. It comes with a spare body and extensive spares. Ready to race.
